"Bumps" against a hard, solid, relatively small surface are responsible for a high percentage of beef bruise damage, Livestock Conservation, Inc., points out. "Bumps" in the hip area are responsible for damage to the loin cut of the carcass and accounts for some 60 per cent or more of the total beef bruise damage.

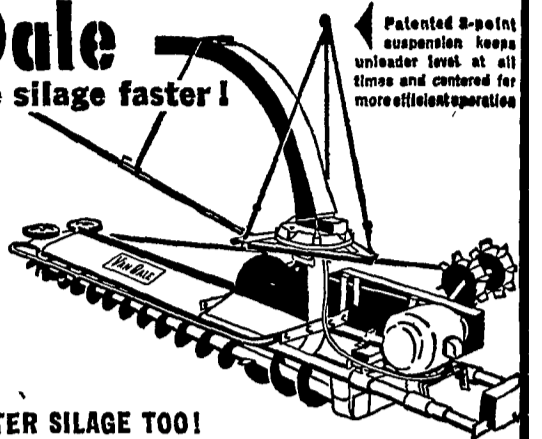

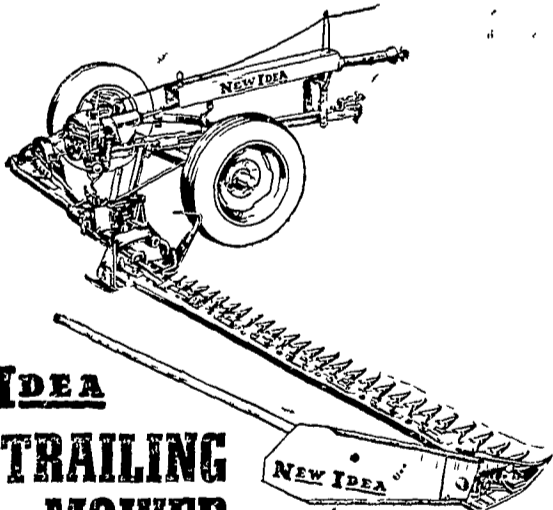
