Hogs and Calves at the April 15 auction at New Holland

showed improvement. Hogs were active and tully 50 higher. Calves were from 1.00 to 2.00 higher.

There were 401 hogs in the run. Retail hogs to local butchers brought 16 to 17.25. Grades 1 to 3 to the packer brought 15.5 to 16 and heavyweight hogs over 240 pounds brought 14.75 to 15.5.

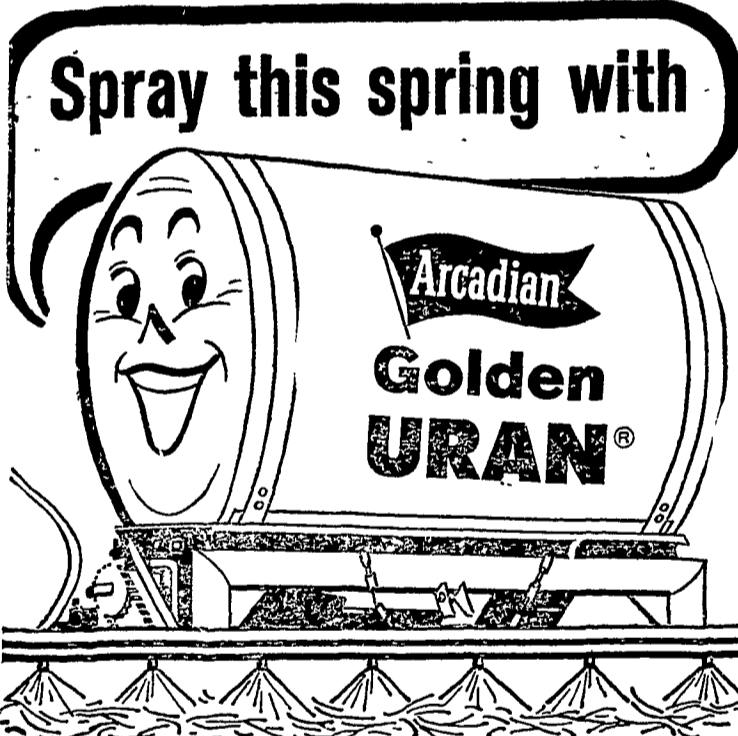
Seventy eight calves were sold. Choice and prime vealers brought 36 to 42, good and low choice were 30-36, standard 24-30, and cull and common were 18 to 24.

The 78 cows, 2 bulls and 31 heifers at the April 17 sale of dairy cattle met a steady market.

Fresh Holstein cows were \$275-400, Guernseys \$150-225, and other breeds \$150-250. Stock bulls were \$135-210 and stock heifers were \$65-140.

A total of 254 horses, ponies and mules at the April 15 sale sold on a steady market.

Mules by the pair brought \$275-385 and single mules sold for \$120-180. Pony mares made \$69-90 and geldings were \$40-115. Riding horses made \$125-240 and driving horses were \$125-200. Killer horses brought 7 to 7½ cents a pound.

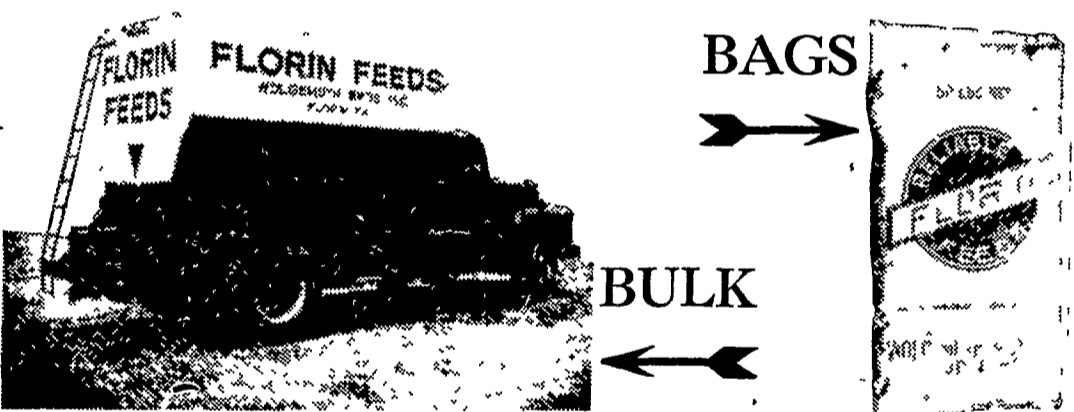
