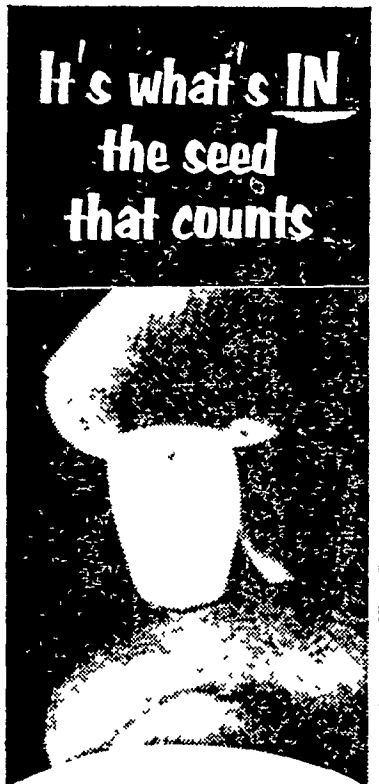
## 4-H Holstein See Demonstration
