HERE'S WHY:

- **ENERGY INTAKE MUST BE CONSTANT** at .3 therms per pound of milk for efficient production.
- **HOT WEATHER** cuts down nutrients from pasture because pasture quality deteriorates rapidly and cows won't graze in the hot sun.
- **RAPIDLY GROWING PASTURES** are high in water content and may supply inadequate nutrients even though cows eat enough to be full.
- **"HARVESTING" PASTURE** increases cow's needs for energy. Increase may be as much as 40% compared to barn feeding.
