



.Green Pastures **Dairy Pellets**

HERE'S WHY:

- ENERGY INTAKE MUST BE CON-**STANT** at .3 therms per pound of milk for efficient production.
 - RAPIDLY GROWING PASTURES are high in water content and may supply inadequate nutrients even though cows eat enough to be full.
- HOT WEATHER cuts down nutrients from pasture because pasture quality deteriorates rapidly and cows won't graze in the hot sun.
- "HARVESTING" PASTURE increases cow's needs for energy. Increase may be as much as 40% compared to barn feeding.
