New Holland reported a steady market on dairy cattle at the May 15 auction. There were 76 cows, two bulls and four heifers.

Fresh Holstein cows brought \$275-475; Guernseys \$150-225; and other breeds \$150-250. Stock bulls brought \$140-235, and stock heifers made \$75-160.

Prices were about steady at the May 13 auction of horses as 285 head crossed the block.

Pony mares brought \$60-115 and gelded ponies were \$40-150. Riding horses sold for \$130-300 and driving horses made \$130-265. Killer horses were 7 to 7½ cents.

The 368 hogs at the May 13 auction sold 50 higher. Retail hogs to local butchers brought 17-18. Wholesale grades 1-3 to packers were 16-16.75, while heavy hogs over 240 pounds were 15-16.

The calf market on May 13 was steady as 75 head sold. Choice and prime veal brought 34-38; good and low choice were 30-34; standard 24-28, and common were 18-24.

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
