

All Lots Listed Are Sold

All birds on offer were sold at the May 16 auction at the Lancaster Poultry Center.

Broilers gained nearly three quarters of a cent as 139,050 head in 23 lots brought 16.3 to 16.6, mostly 16.5. The sale average on broilers was 16.49 compared to the 15.84 last week. Broilers at the comparable sale last year averaged 16.14 cents. Five lots sold at the top price.

One lot of 975 roasters brought 24.8 and two lots of 1,050 pullets brought 25. Two lots containing 1,850 leghorn fowl brought 9 and 10 cents a pound.

The complete sale offered and sold a total of 142,925 head in 28 lots.

Prices Increase; Demand Good

Live broiler prices increased nearly a quarter cent in Delmarva during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 Friday morning. The demand was good for the light offerings, though processors resisted the higher prices. Ready to cook demand was spotty ranging from slow to fair.

With practically no plants operating Saturday, the estimated slaughter by eastern shore processors for the week end was 783,000 head compared to the 764,000 head last week end.

Delmarva reported at farm prices of 15 8 to 16 3 for 988,-600 head including 472,900 head sold at Thursday's sale at Selbyville, Del. Forty-three per cent of the sales were between 16 0 and 16.3.

Under the program, farmers may substitute wheat for corn, sorghum or barley in their feed grain allotments, or they may substitute feed grains for wheat.

The measure is a two year program aimed at bringing government owned feed grains down to a normal carry-over level.

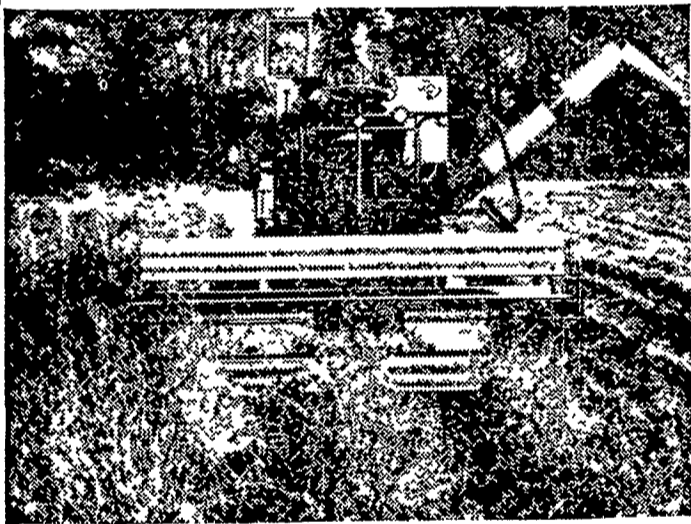
