close watch on the reproductive success of wild turkeys, ringneck pheasants, rutted grouse, bobwhite quail and mourning doves. They will report the number and size of broods observed throughout the nesting and learing season from May until September.

Game protectors and field biologists will also start reporting late this month on the number and size of upland game biid broods. The report includes the total number of young observed in each pheasant, quail and grouse brood. Wild turkey broods are fur-1400 lbs, 2150-2250 with 2225, Good 2050-2225, Stan- ther broken down by age class. Quail-sized poults are classed as 0-3 weeks of age, grouse-Cows. Utility and Commer-size turkeys as 3-6 weeks, weeks and large, chicken-size young turkeys as 9-12 weeks of age Also included in the spring survey is a woodcock population survey. Qualified observers travel 28 routes through the major woodcock breeding grounds in Pennsylvania and report on the number of "singing" males heard.


