

**LANCASTER POULTRY CENTER**

**Prices, Volume Are Steady**

Live broiler prices and numbers were just about steady with last week at the June 27 auction at the Lancaster Poultry Center. A total of 124,800 head in 16 lots changed hands at prices ranging from 15.4 to 16.0 for a sale average of 15.66.

The high lot was 1200 White Mountains at nine weeks consigned by Richard Buckwalter and purchased by Martin Brendle.

Two lots of 1,600 leghorn fowl brought 9.4 and 10.0. A lot of 650 roasters sold for 22.1 and a lot of 1,000 pullets brought 21.9. One lot of 450 heavy fowl changed hands at 17.2.

The complete sale offered 144,700 head in 31 lots and sold 128,500 head in 21 lots.

**Delmarva Record Number Plants Operating**

Delmarva reported prices of 15 to 15 8 for reported purchases of 892,000 head at farms during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning.

Ready to cook demand very heavy for the holiday market and a record number of plants were reported operating today. Estimated slaughter for the week end was 1,938,000 head compared to the 701,000 head last week end.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending June 21 was up one point from the previous week to 3.1. Broilers averaged 15.50 per pound and 20 per cent mash cost the grower \$101.00 per ton.

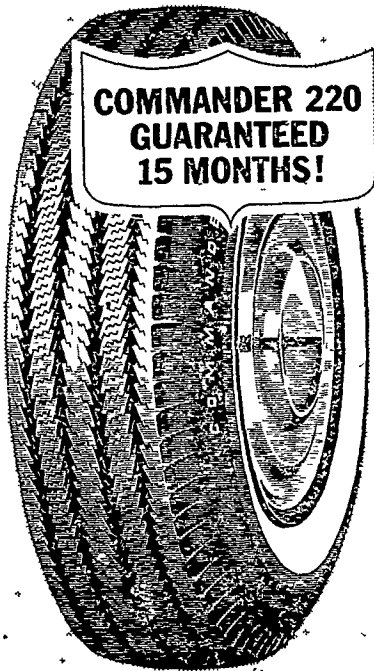

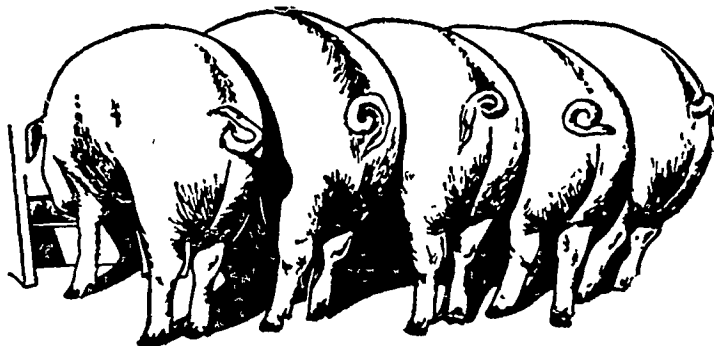

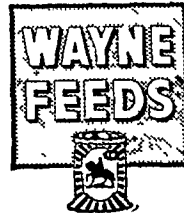
