butors, dealers or their representatives or anyone employed by a farm equipment firm either on a full or part time basis shall not be eligible to enter as a contestant.

Each contestant shall be required to furnish his own plow, tractor, fuel and repair parts. Only moldboard plows will be permitted in the contest. Contestants will be scored on furrow straightness, quick

penetration, smooth furrow turned when the contestant bottom, adhering to boundaries, completes plowing his plot. trash coverage, even furrow. Degrees of Shrinkage

Many terms describe degrees of shrinkage, explains Bernice Tharp, Penn State extension clothing specialist. Sanforized means a fabric won't shrink more than 1 per cent in either length or width. Preshrunk should be followed by a few words that state how much fabric will shrink. Often a label reads "preshrunk — will not shrink more than 1 per cent." Shrinkproof, unshrinkable, and will not shrink are not accurate terms.
