

# Broilers Are Down Slightly Heavy Weights Are In Demand

Broiler prices slipped slightly at the July 18 auction at the Lancaster Poultry Center. A total of 23 lots containing 138,500 broilers brought prices of 15.9 to 16.5 for a sale average of 16.08. Average at last week's sale was 16.48.

Two lots containing 900 roasters sold at 19. One lot of 1,750 leghorn fowl brought 10.1, and one lot of 1,000 heavy fowl changed hands at 15.3.

The complete auction offered 152,450 birds in 32 lots and sold 142,150 birds in 27 lots.

## Delmarva

Delmarva reported prices declined slightly during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 Friday morning. The high side of prices was paid for the heavier weight birds.

A fair demand took the heavy auction offerings, though practically no plants planned to operate Saturday.

Estimated slaughter by eastern shore processors for the week end was 734,000 head compared to the 868,000 head last week end.

Prices during the period ranged 15 3 to 16 6 for 1,470, 200 head at farms, including 566,200 head purchased at Thursday's auction at Selbyville, Del.

The Delmarva broiler feed ratio for the week ending July 12 was 3 2, the same as the previous week. Broilers averaged 16 13 per pound and mash cost the grower \$100 49 per ton.
