have been cut in this county, there will not be a continuous supply." Kitch believes. He pointed out that only 13 per cent of the county's land area is in woodland. But even with this small percentage of wooded area, timber is an important crop on many farms if it is properly cared for.

This is the job of the service forester — to help the landowner properly care for his crop of timber.

This, too is agriculture, I thought.
