

## Record Number Of SPABC Show Entries; Three Other Shows

The largest cattle show in the history of the Southeastern Pennsylvania Artificial Breeders Cooperative is scheduled to be held at the co-op grounds, Route 230 bypass, next week.

In addition to the SPABC show, the county 4-H roundup, a Brown Swiss Canton show, and the south-central Black and White show will be held on the same grounds during the week.

With 451 entries, the SPABC show will be the largest in the 12 year history of the annual exhibitions. A total of 243 Holsteins, 68 Guernseys, 60 Ayrshires, 49 Jerseys, and 31 Brown Swiss cattle have been entered, approximately 30 more than last year.

The Brown Swiss Canton number 5 show is set to begin at 10 a. m., July 29, with Paul W. Anderson, dairy specialist from the Pennsylvania State University, as judge.

All entries in the SPABC colored breeds must check in on the grounds before 5 p. m., July 29, and judging will begin at 10 a. m. July 30. Ayrshires and Brown Swiss will be judged in one end of the tent while Guernseys and Jerseys are being placed at the other end.

Judging of the Guernseys and Jerseys will be by Lee Yost, manager of Wyno Farms, Muncy, while Ayrshires and Brown Swiss will be placed by Cuthbert Nann, Ayrshire breeder of Douglassville, Berks

County.

The 4-H colored breeds will be shown beginning at 6 p. m. on July 30, and 4-H Holsteins must check in on that evening. Judging of the 4-H Holsteins will begin at 9 a. m. on July 31.

Judge of the 4-H show will be George Fry. Brown Swiss breeds from Ceciltown, Md. Entries include 70 Holsteins, 52 Guernseys, 21 Ayrshires, six Jerseys, and six Brown Swiss.

The SPABC Holsteins will check in before 5 p. m., July 31 and be ready for judging at 10 a. m., August 1. Placing the black and white entries will be Richard Keene, Holstein breeder and part time classifier from Gilbertsville, N. Y.

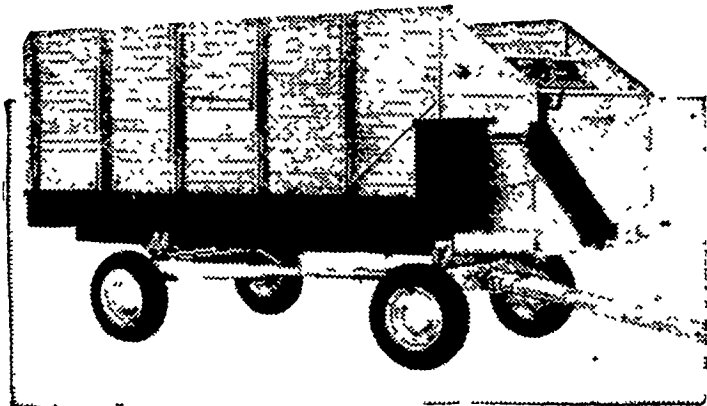
On Friday, August 2, the South-central Pennsylvania Black and White Show will take over the arena.

During the SPABC show, all the cooperative's facilities will be open for inspection and guided tours will be conducted through the bull barns, laboratory and offices.

All judging in the SPABC and 4-H shows will be on the Danish system. The cooperative will furnish bedding, water and a portable milker. Exhibitors are expected to furnish hay and grain.
