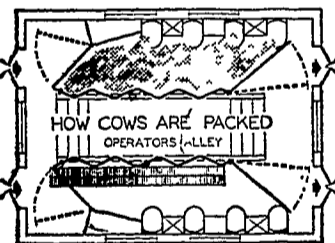

**Plowing Contest**

(Continued from Page 1) as Groff turned a very smooth finish furrow in the barley stubble on the farm of Roy Garber, Lititz R3. In contrast to the 1962 contest, when dust was so thick contestants were hard put to see their boundary markers, the current site was conditioned somewhat by Monday night's thundershowers. Judges Glenn Miller, Lebanon County Agent; John W. Sangrey, Conestoga R2, and Martin Muth, Soil Conservation Service, awarded the winner 147 points on his finish-

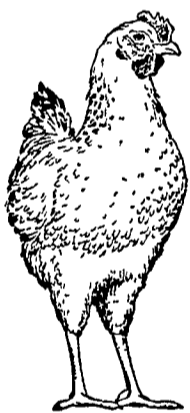
ing furrow, 129 points on the back furrow and 19 on the main furrows, 101 on the tilled surface and 30 points for safe operation of his rig. The twenty-five year old carpenter, and part time farmer drove a 530 John Deere with a two-bottom, three point hitch plow. After finishing second in the 1962 tilt, Groff practiced his furrow turning on his seven acre farm where he raises tobacco, corn and barley. He will represent the county in the level land division of

the state plowing contest August 15 on the farm of Joseph Hooker, Barnville, Pa. Combining field day activities with the plowing contest, exhibits were maintained on the site by the Pennsylvania Game Commission, Lancaster County Production Credit Association and the Federal Land Bank Association of Lancaster, all cooperating agencies of the Lancaster County Soil Conservation District, sponsor of the event.
