pounds of milk and 58 pounds of butterfat.

John C. Metzler had a registered Holstein that finished with 21,058 pounds of milk and 823 pounds of butterfat, and Clarence L. Keener had a Holstein cow with a record of 19,466 pounds of milk and 809 pounds of butterfat.

Earl L. Groff and Hiram Aungst had averages of 57 pounds of butterfat and the following herds had 56 pound averages: Hess and Grosh, Clarence Stauffer, Red Rose Research Center, Aaron K. Stoltzfus and John E. Esh. Twenty-six other herds had averages of 50 pounds or more.
