

# Off 2c In 2 Weeks

Live broiler prices dropped more than two cents a pound in the past two weeks at the Lancaster Poultry Center. At the August 1 sale a total of 106,398 broilers in 25 lots were sold at prices ranging from 14.2 to 15.0 for a sale average of 14.4.

A lot of 800 heavy fowl brought 16.1 while a lot of 300 Leghorn fowl sold for 9 cents a pound. One lot of 1,200 pullets at nine weeks crossed the block at 16, and a lot of heavier pullets changed hands at 17.75.

Only two listed lots failed to sell. A lot of 650 White Vantress at 9 weeks was bid to 13.5, and a lot of 550 White Vantress cross pullets at 13 weeks was withdrawn at the bid of 17.7.

The complete sale offered 110,888 head in 31 lots and sold 109,838 head in 29 lots.

### Broilers Down A Quarter Cent

Delmarva reported live broiler prices declined more than a quarter cent during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning with demand fully ample for light auction offerings.

Prices ranged 13.6 to 15.1 at farms for reported purchases of 833,200 head including 422,200 head sold at Thursday's auction at Selbyville, Del. Over half the sales were at less than 14.4.

Estimated slaughter for the week end by Eastern Shore processors was 949,000 head compared to the 824,000 head last week end.

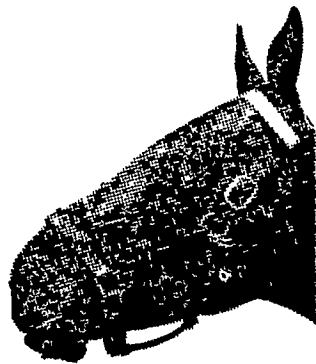
