auditorium. The meeting will begin at 1:30 p.m.

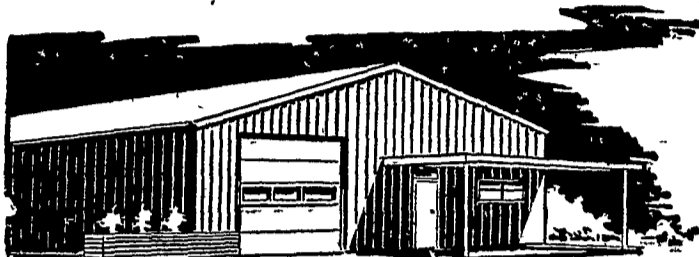
Buying Snap Beans

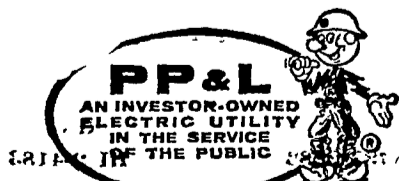
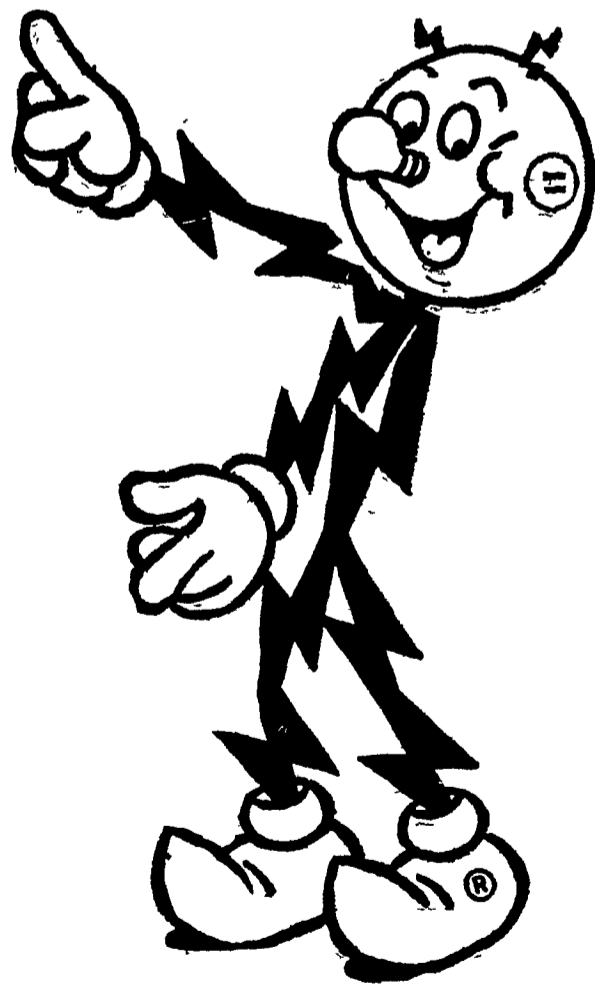
