

Prices Up 1.5 Cents

Live broiler prices edged up fractionally as a large volume crossed the block at the August 15 auction in the Lancaster Poultry Center.

A total of 164,000 broilers in 32 lots changed hands at prices ranging from 15.8 to 16.3 for a sale average of 16.01.

Four lots of pullets including 6,700 head sold at 17.7 to 18.4, and one lot of 800 leghorn fowl brought 9.6.

The complete sale offered 177,080 head in 39 lots and sold 171,580 head in 37 lots.

Slightly Lower Prices Reported

Delmarva reported slightly lower prices on live broilers during the 24 hour period ending 10.30 Friday morning. Prices of 14.9 to 16.5 were reported at farms for 1,058,900 head including 465,700 head sold at Thursday's Eastern Shore Poultry Growers Exchange.

Estimated slaughter for the week end was 869,000 head compared to the 898,000 head last week end.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending August 9 was 3.0 compared to the 2.9 for the previous week. Broilers averaged 15.11 per pound and mash cost the grower \$102.34 per ton. The ratio for the comparable week a year earlier was 3.5 when broilers brought 16.35 and mash cost \$93.31 per ton.

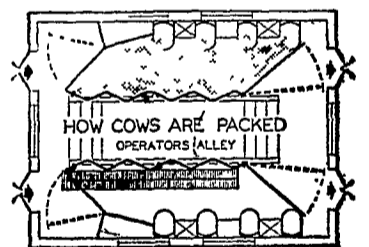

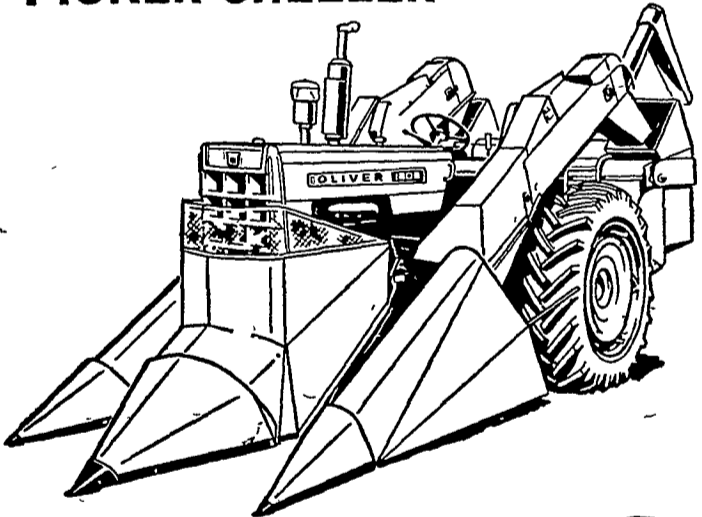

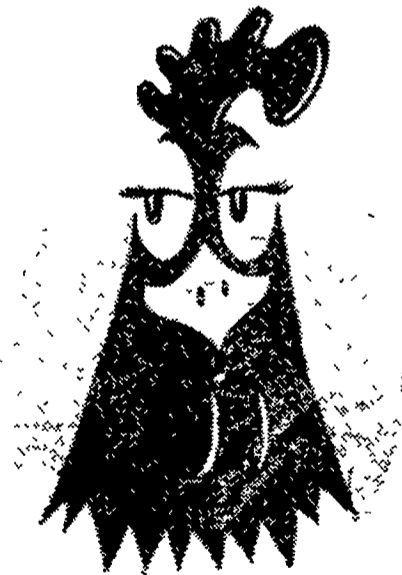
