Caution During Storms
Isolated trees in open fields are dangerous to people and livestock during electrical storms. Such trees can be protected with a lightning rod installed on the tree with ground cable running down the trunk into moist soil. N. Henry Wooding, Penn State extension agricultural engineer, suggests these precautions during electrical storms. If possible, stay inside a building where it is dry and stay away from open fireplaces, open windows, and open doorways. Avoid metal objects if the building is not protected by lightning rods.
