silo will last all winter," he said. He said he believes the steers do well on the green chopped corn if it is not too young. He waits until the husks begin to turn brown before chopping.

In addition to raising steers, hogs, 700 laying hens, five ac-

res of tobacco, 30 acres of corn, 12 acres of wheat, five acres of barley and eight acres of alfalfa, and driving a cattle truck, Zimmerman also does custom combining, silo filling, and a little corn picking.

He believes in feeding his

crops well and handling them as little as possible when they are ready to harvest.

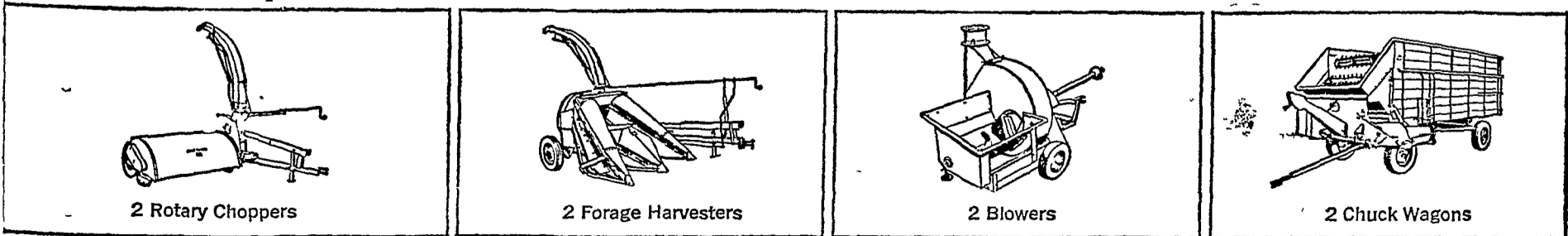
