

LANCASTER POULTRY CENTER

Prices Down One Cent

Live broiler prices at the September 12 auction at the Lancaster Poultry Center dropped more than a cent a pound from the previous week.

A total of 125,200 broilers in 18 lots ranged from 15.1 to 15.5 for a sale average of 15.18. The high lot of broilers was 800 White Vantress Cockerels at eight weeks consigned by Clarence Huber and purchased by W. C. Mellinger and Son. All broilers on offer were sold.

One lot of 1,000 pullets brought 24.5; a lot of 800 roasters sold for 18.1, and a lot of 800 pullets at eight weeks brought 17.

Three lots including 2,200 leghorn fowl ranged 9.1 to 9.2, and three lots including 680 heavy fowl brought 18.1.

The complete sale offered 135,934 head in 31 lots and sold 130,743 head in 27 lots.

Delmarva

Price Continues To Decline

Delmarva reported prices of 14 1/2 to 15.6 for 782,900 head at farms during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 Friday morning.

These prices represented a decline of more than a quarter cent over the previous day and include the sale of 392,300 head sold at Thursday's auction in Selbyville, Del. Demand was only fair for light auction offerings.

Estimated slaughter for the week end was 820,000 head compared to the 925,000 head slaughtered last week end by eastern shore processors.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio, for the week ending September 6 was steady at 3.0. Broilers averaged 15.40 during the week and 20 per cent mash cost the grower \$102.05 per ton. The ratio for the comparable week a year ago was 3.8 when broilers averaged 17.89 and mash cost \$95.31 per ton

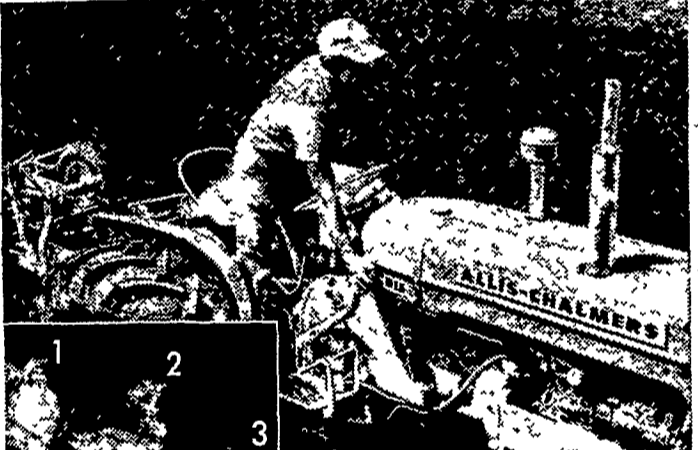

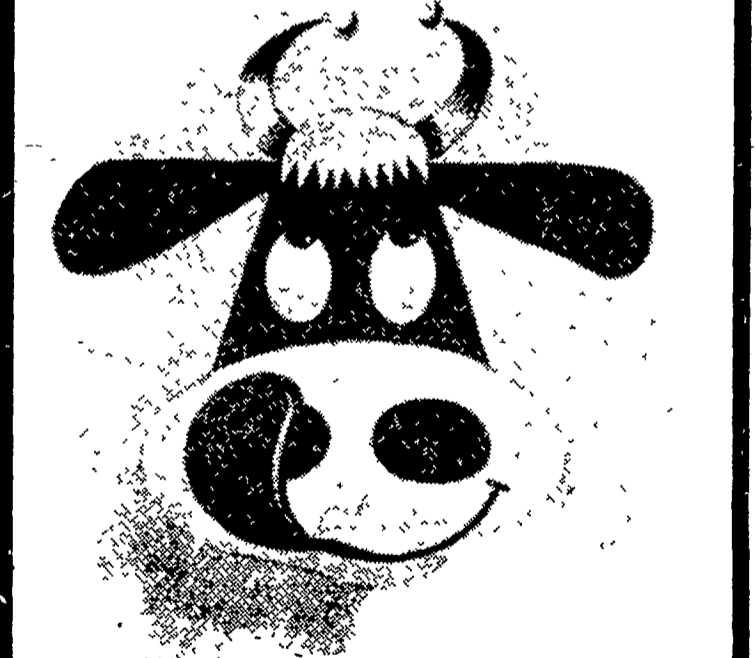
