(Continued from Page 4) fected and permitted to be empty for at least two weeks each year. If possible this practice should be applied between the spring and the fall pig crops each year. The idle period is useful to break the disease cycle of any infection that is present in the building or in the herd.

Snowshoe rabbits are legal game in Pennsylvania from Dec. 26 to Jan. 4, 1964, except in the eleven closed counties of Bedford, Blair, Cambria, Centre, Elk, Forest, Huntingdon, Jefferson, McKean, Somerset and Warren. The daily bag limit is two and the season limit is six.

The bear hunting season this year is from Nov. 25 to 30 with a season limit of one per individual and two for a party.

A total of 115,000 forest fires last year burned over four million acres.

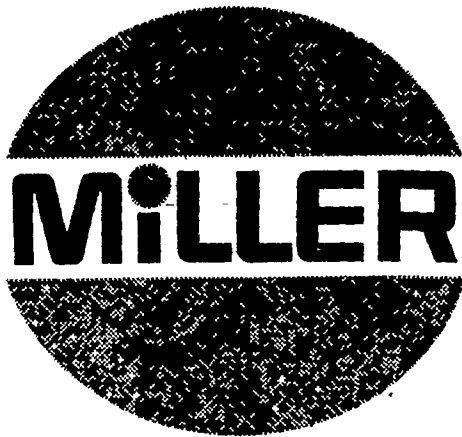

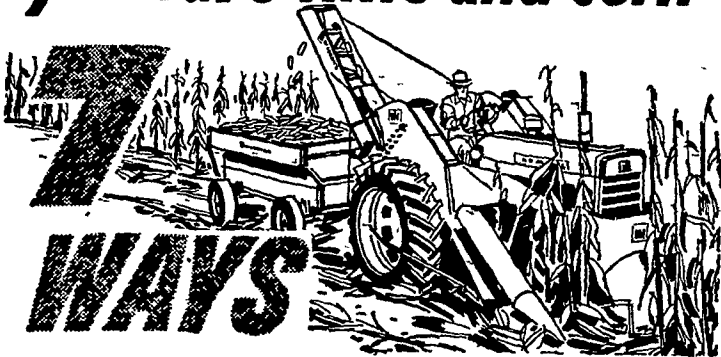
