William G. Carlin, President of the Producers Cooperative Exchange, Coatesville, reported recently to the Board of Directors a volume of 9,696,610 dozen eggs were marketed during fiscal year ending September 30, up ten percent over last fiscal year.

Total sales of all products was \$4,053,753, up nine percent; savings of \$23,000, was more than doubled over last year.

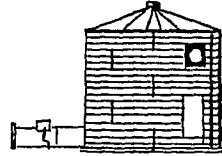

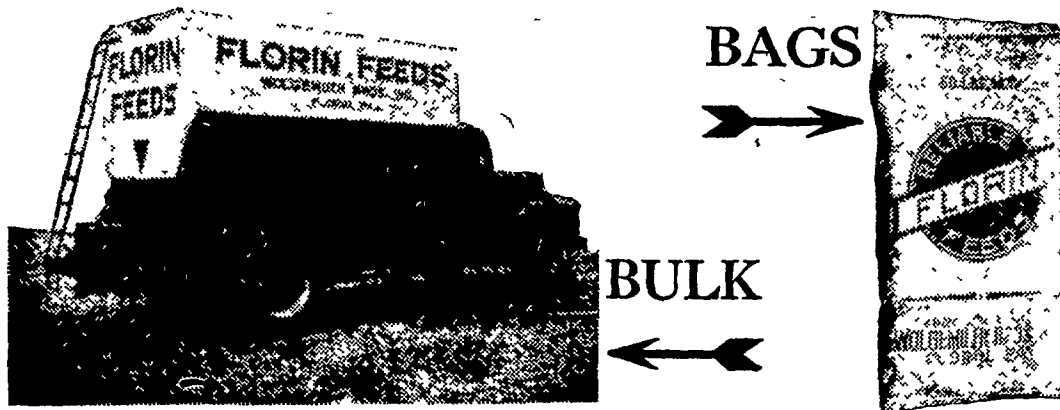
