The 175 cows, nine bulls and 15 heifers met a steady

market at the October 23 of dairy cattle.

Fresh Holstein cows brought \$275-410; Guernseys \$17-240, and other breeds \$11-270. Stock bulls were \$11-185, and stock heifers brought \$65-140.

At the October 21 auction of horses and ponies the 28 head sold steady. Riding horses brought \$100-200, and driving horses sold for \$100-150. Pony mares were \$40-90, and geldings brought \$30-90.

The 391 hogs at the October 21 sale were steady. Retail hogs to local butchers brought 18.25-19. Grades 1 to 3 went to packers at 16 85-17 35, and heavyweight hogs brought 16 60 to 16.75. Sows sold at 15 to 15.50.

The October 21 sale saw 11 calves sell at steady prices. Choice and prime vealers brought 33-38; good and choice 29-33; standard 25-30 and common 15-25.

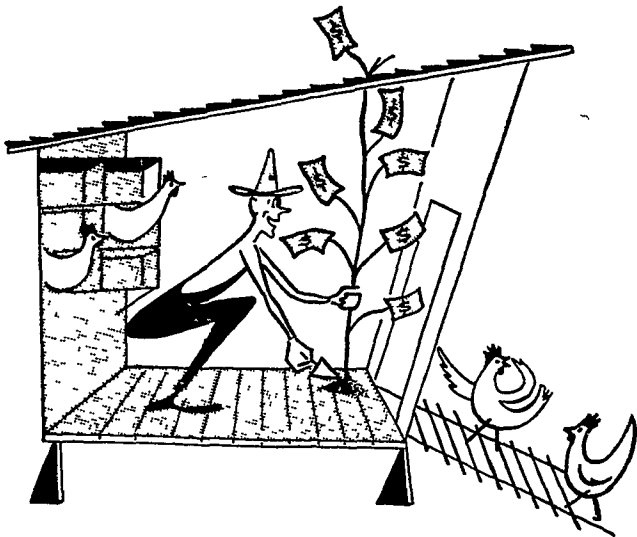
