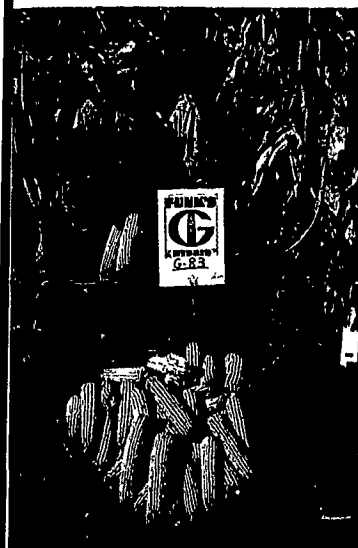


Each large, plump ear produced by Funk's G-83 is well filled to the tip—and deep kernels are packed with extra feed value.

FUNK'S G-83



Funk's G-83, with more capacity to produce, jumps right up in yield when planted thicker and fertilized heavier. It's highly uniform—carries its ears low on stalks.
