Scholarship Awarded To Former Countian

A former Assistant Lancaster County agent has been named to receive a \$200 scholarship grant, it was learned this week.

Clarence E. Craver, McKean county agent, has been named recipient of the award provided jointly by the Pennsylvania Association of Extension Home Economists, the Pennsylvania Association of County Agricultural Agents, the Extension Professors Association, and Alpha Omicron chapter of Epsilon Sigma Phi.

Now at The Pennsylvania State University for graduate study, Craver will be on sabbatical leave until March 31, 1964.

Native of Indiana county, where his parents operated a dairy farm near Cherry Tree, Craver was graduated from Cherry Tree high school and in June, 1949 he received a degree in agriculture from Penn State where he majored in dairying. He was a member of the Dairy Science Club and assisted in staging the annual Dairy Expositions.

While a student, he took the Dairy Herd Improvement Association short course to qualify for testing during summer vacations. He also did advanced registry work.

Following graduation he was appointed assistant county agent in Lancaster. On July 1, 1954, he was promoted to associate agent in Blair county, and on June 1, 1956, was named McKean county agent.

Mr. Craver and his wife, the former Polly Rockey, of Petersburg, have two children, Candace 12, and Craig 6.

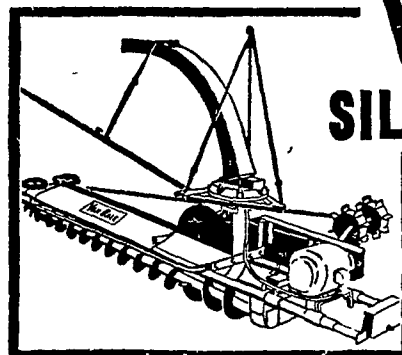

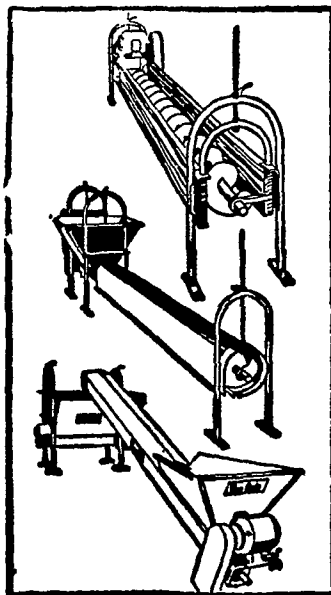
