 2 tablespoons lemon juice
 7 baked tart shells
 1/2 cup chopped walnuts
 1/2 cup heavy cream, whipped
 Combine prunes, apples sugar, flour, cinnamon nutmeg, cloves, salt and lemon juice; cook, stirring constantly, until thickened. Pour into baked tart shells. Sprinkle each with chopped nuts. Just before serving, top with whipped cream. Makes 7 tarts.

PRUNE COTTAGE CHEESE PIE

1 cup plumped, pitted, chopped prunes
 1/4 cup light brown sugar
 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
 Juice and grated rind of 1 lemon
 9 or 10-inch unbaked pastry shell
 1 pound cottage cheese
 1/2 cup granulated sugar
 2 tablespoons flour
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 3 eggs, separated
 1/2 cup heavy cream
 Thoroughly mix prunes, brown sugar, spices and half the lemon juice; spread evenly over bottom of pastry shell.

Put cheese through a sieve or food mill. Combine with 1/4 cup sugar, flour and salt. Beat in egg yolks, cream and remaining lemon juice and rind. Whip egg whites stiff, gradual-

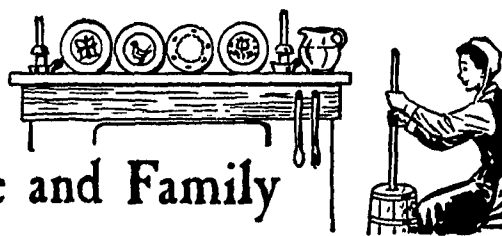
ly heating in remaining 1/4 cup sugar; fold meringue into cheese mixture. Carefully spoon mixture over prune layer in pastry shell. Bake in a slow oven, 300 degrees, for 1 hour. Then increase temperature to 350 degrees, and continue baking for 45 minutes. Makes 19 or 10-inch pie.

FRUITED CREAM

1 cup pineapple chunks
 1 cup plumped, pitted, chopped prunes
 1 cup orange sections
 1/4 cup sugar
 2 cups diced sponge cake
 1 cup sliced banana
 1/2 cup slivered, toasted almonds
 1 cup heavy cream, whipped
 5 plumped prunes, slivered almonds, fruit slices for garnish

Combine pineapple, prunes, orange sections, sugar and sponge cake cubes; mix well. Refrigerate until needed. Just (Continued on Page 10)

Safety Reminders For The Home

Stairs are not designed for storage . . . keep steps free from all items all the time. If you have basement stairs without a guard rail, spend a few dollars and a few hours work building a guard rail. It will be the best investment in safety you can make. When carrying loads of articles up or down stairs, keep the loads small and carry them to the side so you can see each step. Take time to wipe up spills on the kitchen floor. Avoid scatter rugs . . . they may turn into flying rugs and if this happens their decorative value can be offset by medical costs in case of an accident.

A good stepladder is a worthwhile investment. A chair or box is a poor substitute and can be a costly one.

Use non-slip devices in the bathtub and in the shower.

Good To Try Any Time

A pair of pint size plastic bags serve as gloves when shaping popcorn balls. After the corn is popped, and the syrup is mixed in, pull the bags on your hands just like a pair of mittens. Mold the sticky popcorn together quickly and gently. Plastic protects your hands from the candy coating and popcorn balls roll

smoothly. When you have to carry letters to a mailbox, put them in a plastic bag. Addresses will stay dry and legible.

To save white clothes from possible color bleeds in the ironing bag, wrap prints and doubtful colored articles in individual plastic bags. Slip the smaller bags into the larger one and store damp clothes until ironing time.

Longer Wear From Men's Suits

Try to rotate the wearing of suits so it won't be necessary to wear the same suit on two successive days. A rest period permits wrinkles to hang out by themselves and saves pressing.

Give suits an occasional airing. (Continued on Page 10)

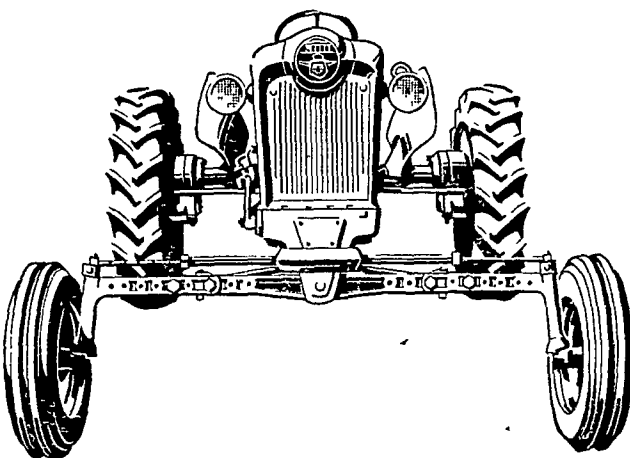
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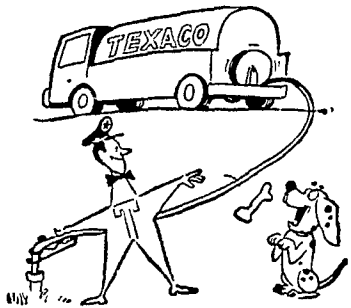
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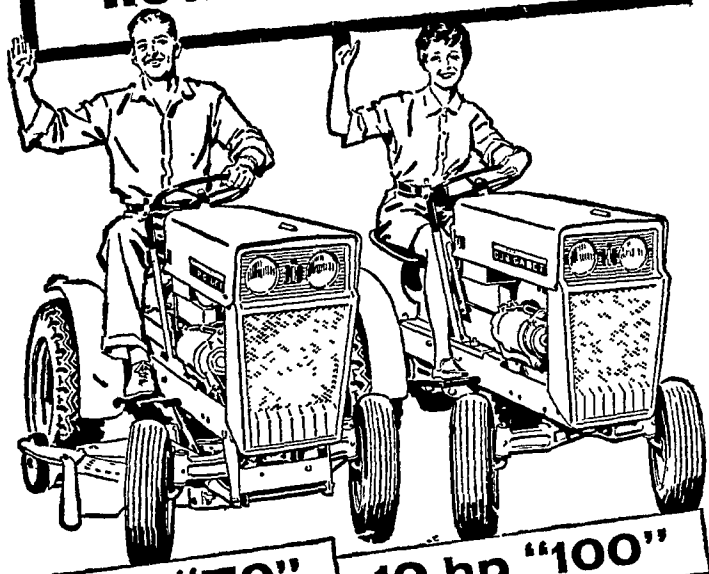
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
