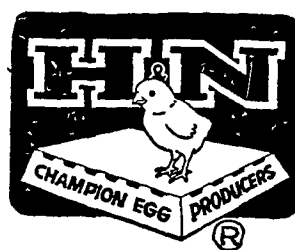

 The 109 dairy cows at the November 13 auction sold about steady. Fresh Holstein cows brought \$275-410; Guernseys \$175-240, and other breeds \$175-270. The two stock bulls brought \$110-185, and the 14 stock heifers sold at \$65-140.  
 A steady market took the 286 head at the November 11 auction of horses. Killers sold lower. Riding horses were \$100-200; driving horses \$100-150, and killer horses 6-8½ cents a pound. Pony mares brought \$40-90, while gelding ponies sold for \$30-90.  
 The 336 head of market hogs sold steady to 25 higher at the November 11 auction. Retail hogs to local butchers brought 18 25 to 19; grades 1, 2 to 3 to the packers sold for 16.35 to 17.10, and heavy weight hogs were 15.25 to 16.25. Sows brought 12.50 to 15.  
 Calves were 1.00 higher at the November 11 auction as 100 head crossed the block. Choice and Prime vealers were 33.50-36.50, good and low choice 30-33; standard 26-30, and cull and common 15-25.

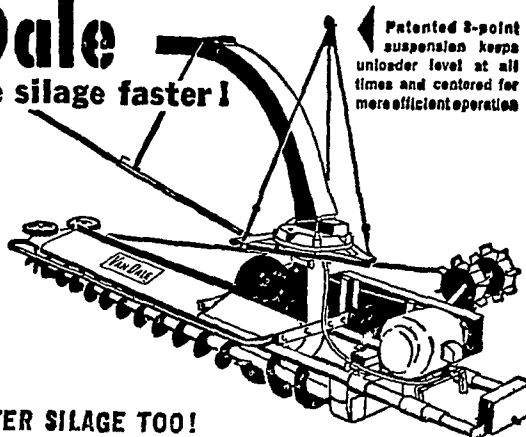
