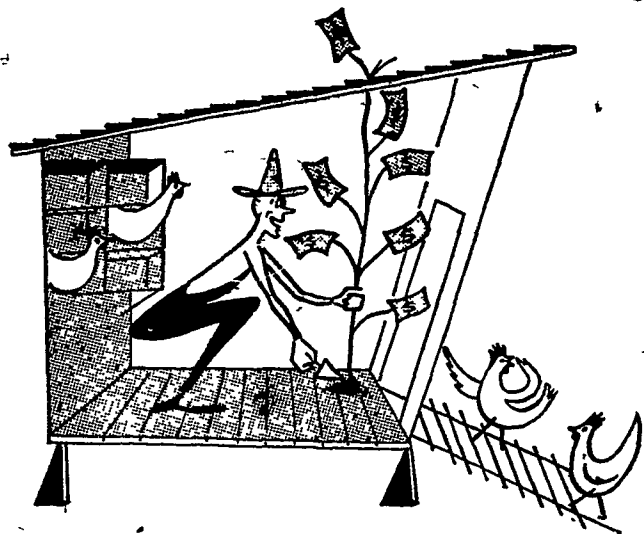

(Continued from Page 9) several purposes include Stayman Winesap, Cortland, Northern Spy, York and McIntosh. The Cortland is especially good for salads since it does not discolor when exposed to air. Stayman Winesap, York and McIntosh are excellent pie apples.

To keep apples firm or whole during cooking add sugar to clean as possible for freezing cooking. For applesauce, sugar should be added after cooking. To improve flavor of less tart apples, add lemon juice.

Baked apples are popular as a dessert, and they may be prepared in many variations. Fill the hollowed-out centers with brown sugar, orange marmalade, raisins and nuts, mincemeat, cranberry sauce or relish, or crushed pineapple. Any of these might be topped with an egg white meringue and then baked at 325 degrees for 50 to 60 minutes. Serve baked apples plain or with cream or a topping made of heavy cream and cream cheese whipped together. For breakfast, serve a baked apple in a bowl of cooked or ready-to-eat cereal.

Applesauce, apple fritters or sliced apple rings are "naturals" with pork chops or roast

meat. For an unusual dessert, serve vanilla ice cream topped with applesauce, with a dash of nutmeg or cinnamon. Apple and cheese wedges make a satisfying "light" dessert.

FREEZING NUTS

With a record crop of pecans, walnuts and almonds predicted, homemakers would do well to consider freezing some for the winter months ahead. Tree nuts are especially easy to freeze. Be sure the nut meats are as dry as possible at the beginning of freezing.

Freeze nuts this easy way: Wash nuts quickly and drain. When dry, crack the shells and remove the meats. Pack nut meats tightly in frozen food containers or polyethylene bags of at least 1 1/2 mil strength. Store at 0 degrees for no longer than a year.

Choose Detergent For Intended Use

When buying laundry products, today's homemaker has to choose between regular and

low-sudsing detergents. No one product is best suited for all washing jobs.

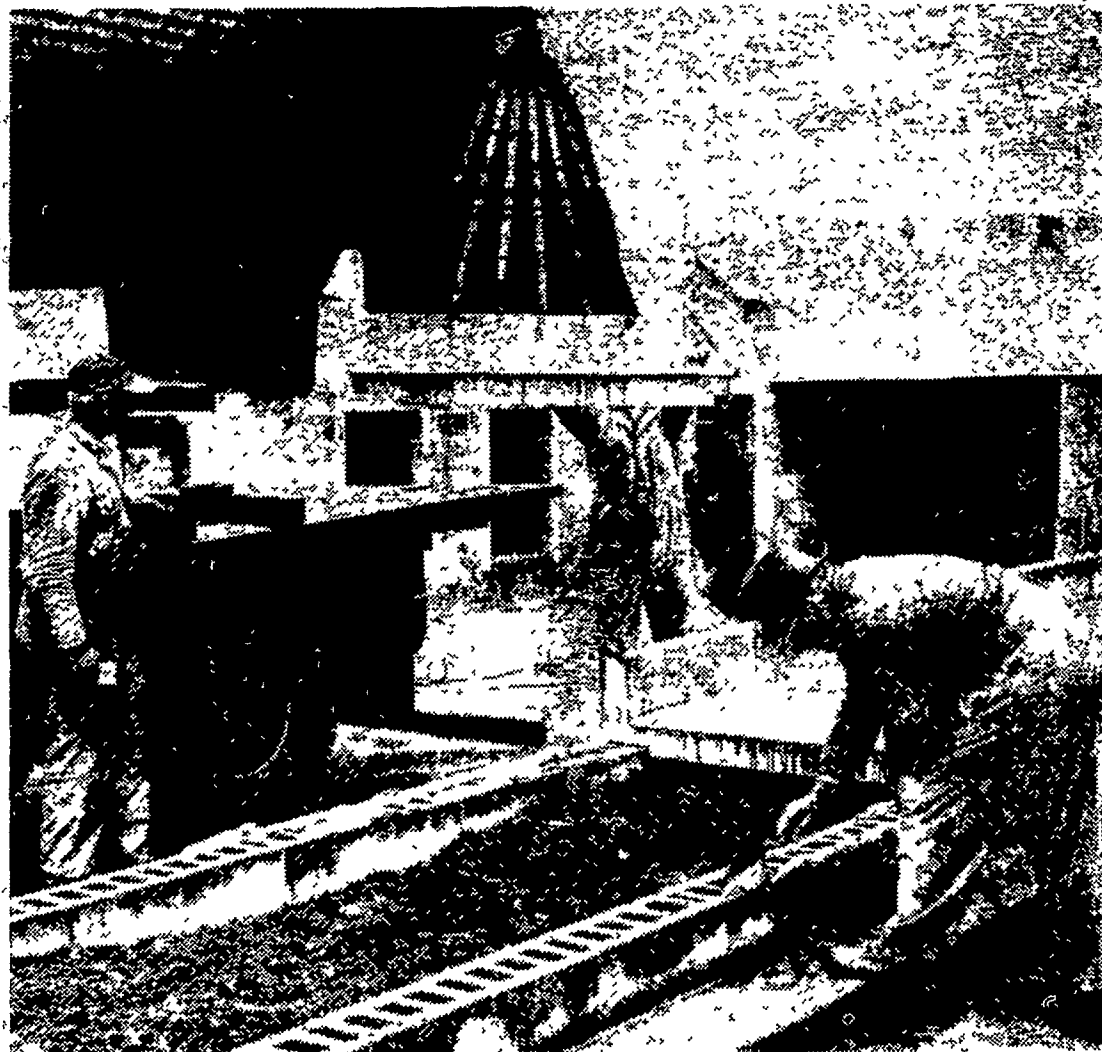
Low-sudsing products may be used in any type washer, but are especially recommended for front-loading automatic washers.

Effectiveness of cleaning is directly related to the amount of washing product used. Often in a front-loading machine it is impossible to use enough regular detergent to gain effective cleaning without causing oversudsing. Excess suds could damage the mechanism of the washer.

When using low-sudsing detergent, a homemaker cannot gauge the amount of detergent she should use by the amount of suds that are formed. To find out the recommended quantity of low-sudsing detergent to use, she should refer to the care and use book that came with her washer, or read instructions on the detergent package.

A good thing to remember is that you don't have to stain your patio deck boards. If you use either western red cedar or Douglas fir you will find that they will weather in a year to a soft, silvery grey. If you stain, you merely ask for a maintenance problem.
