Prices Advance A Half Cent

Delmarva reported prices advanced nearly a half cent since Wednesday and during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning. Demand was good for moderate auction offerings.

Prices at farms ranged 14.6 to 15.8 for 968,000 head including 416,600 head sold at Wednesday's auction in Selbyville, Del.

Estimated slaughter by eastern shore processors for the week end was 788,000 head compared to the 454,000 head last week end.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending November 22 was down four points from the previous week at 2.9. Broilers during the week averaged 14.81 per pound and mash cost the grower \$101.43 per ton. The ratio for the comparable week a year ago was 4.0 when broilers averaged 13.30 per pound and mash cost \$95.31 per ton.
