The 190 head of horses, ponies and mules at the December 2 auction met a stronger market Riding horses brought \$100-400, and driving horses were \$165-325. Mules made \$85-135; pony mares \$75-105, and gelding ponies \$40-80 Killers sold for 6 to 6 1/2 cents a pound

The 389 hogs at the December 2 auction sold 50 lower. Retail hogs to local butchers brought 17 50-18, while grades 1 to 3 went to packers at 15 35-16 35 Heavyweight hogs were 15 25-15 75 The 35 shoats brought \$5 00 to \$12. 50 per head

A steady calf market took the 124 head at the December 2 auction Choice and prime brought 34-37 50, good and low choice 32-34, standard 28-32, and cull and common 15-25

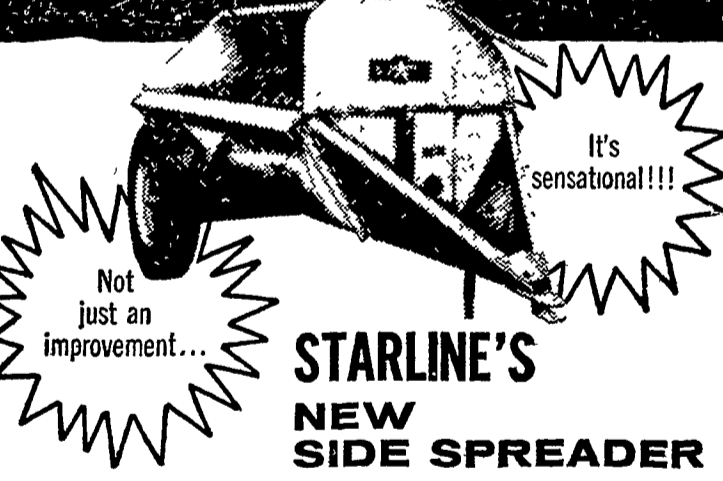

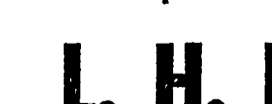
