

## Co. Farm Women Present Play At State Confab

Lancaster County Farm Women will present a play as part of the golden anniversary program of the Pennsylvania State Society of Farm Women during the annual convention January 13 and 14.

Participation in the state program during Farm Show week will be the first special activity on the new year schedule of the county group.

The state convention, which is held in conjunction with the Pennsylvania State Farm Show, will mark the fiftieth anniversary of the organization.

Lancaster County's play, to be presented on January 13, will portray activities of Farm Women over the half-century period by decades.

The Farm Women's organization was begun in Somerset County in 1914. It now encompasses 17 counties in the state with a total membership of 3,500 women. Lancaster County membership numbers approximately 900.

The Lancaster County women also will provide ushers for the Jan. 13 morning session at the convention.

Representatives of the Farm Women also will work at Heart Haven for one week, addressing envelopes and folding seals in preparation for the annual Heart Fund drive.
