

Broilers Down To 12 Cents

Only four lots of broilers were sold at the December 12 auction at the Lancaster Poultry Center. Three of the lots sold at 12 cents and one lot brought 13.

Only 27,300 broilers changed hands. Six lots including 41,600 broilers failed to sell at bids of 10 and 11.

Two lots including 11,800 Leghorn fowl brought 11 cents, and one lot of 300 cockerels sold for 23.1. Five lots including 4,925 pullets sold for 20.3 to 23.5.

The complete sale offered \$1,885 birds in 21 lots and sold 44,385 birds in 12 lots.

Delmarva

Record Low For Live Birds

Live broiler prices in Delmarva set a record low price during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning. Live broilers dropped to 11 2 exceeding the previous low of 11 82 set on November 14, 1961.

Demand was draggy, and ready to cook demand was light.

Estimated slaughter for the week end by eastern shore processors was 839,000 head compared to the 864,000 head last week end.

Prices at farms ranged from 11 2 to 12 3 for 1,131,700 head including 228,900 head sold of 590,500 head offered at Thursday's sale in Selbyville, Del.

Six per cent of the sales were at 11 2 to 11 4, and 16 per cent were 11 5 to 11 9. Only eight per cent went over 12, while the balance were either undetermined or inter company transfers.

The Delmarva broiler-teeed ratio for the week ending December 6 was down one point from the previous week at 2 8. Broilers during the week averaged 14 24 and mash cost the grower \$100 57 per ton.

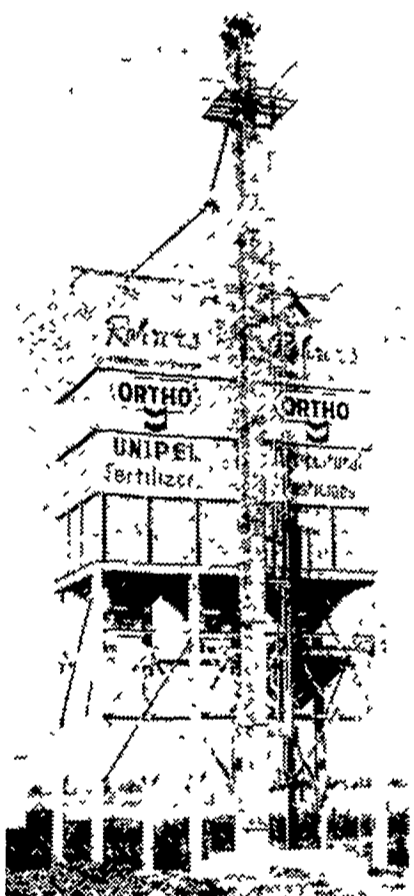
