CARLISLE — Harry E. Unge, Chambersburg, has been re-elected director and chairman of District 18 American Dairy Association and Dairy Council of New York.

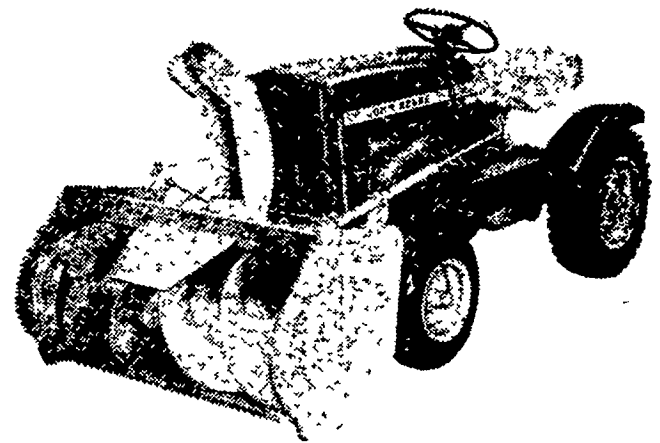
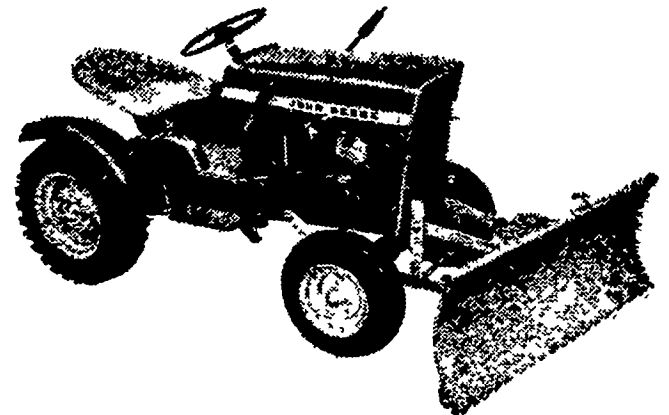
