won't start if more than one cycle has been pushed, check the control setting.

If the washer stops during the spin cycle, rearrange the clothes and start the machine again. Uneven distribution may have been the cause.

If the dryer stops, wait a few minutes to see if it will start again by itself. Most dryers have an overload protector.

GROUND BEEF SAUVORIES

- 1 pound ground beef
 - 2 tablespoons chopped parsley
 - 1 teaspoon garlic salt
 - 1/2 teaspoon salt
 - 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
 - 1 egg yolk
 - Crackers
 - Ketchup
 - Mustard
- Mix ground beef, parsley, garlic salt, salt, black pepper and egg yolk. Roll 1 table-

spoon of mixture in a ball. Place on a cracker. Make a hollow in center of meatball. Fill half centers with ketchup and half with prepared mustard. Place crackers on a baking sheet. Bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees) 20 minutes. Serve hot. Makes about 30.

ORANGE CHEESE SNACKS

- 1 8-ounce package cream cheese
 - 2 tablespoons orange juice
 - 2 teaspoons grated orange rind
- Mix softened cream cheese with orange juice and orange rind. Spread on crackers. Garnish with maraschino cherries and mincemeat, pineapple tidbits or cashew nuts. Serve immediately. Makes about 30 snacks

CRANBERRY DIP

- 1 8-ounce package softened cream cheese
- 1/4 cup commercial sour cream
- 1/2 cup finely chopped fresh or frozen cranberries

1 tablespoon grated orange rind
1 tablespoon confectioners' sugar
Crackers

Mix softened cream cheese, sour cream, chopped cranberries, orange rind and confectioners' sugar. Chill. Serve with crackers. Makes about 1 1/2 cups.

Protect House Plants
Keep house plants away from radiators, but guard against freezing on cold nights especially where these plants are close to windows. You can get more information from The Pennsylvania State University Circular 491, "Growing Better House Plants." Ask your county agricultural agent for a copy.

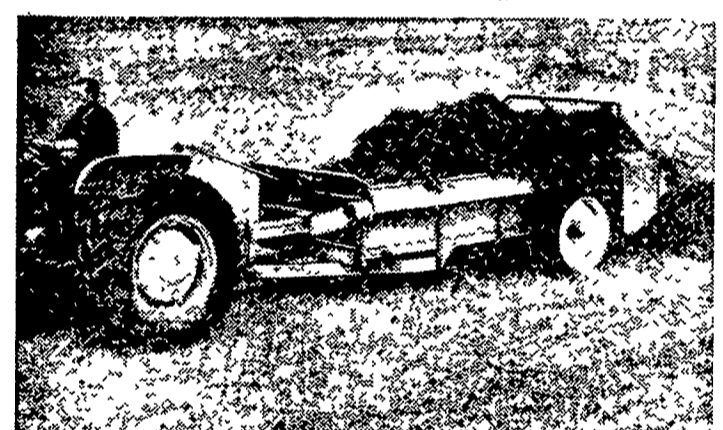

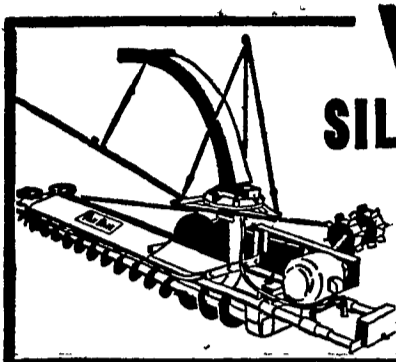

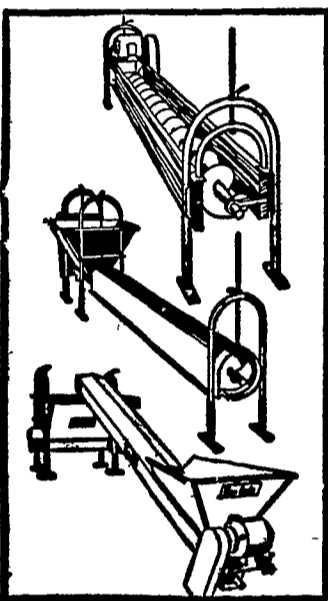
