His thesis dealt with the effects of spring clipping and stage of maturity at first cutting on yield and nutritive value of first and second-cutting mixed hays.

Reared on a farm, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Herman A. Shirk, Glenn had ten years of 4-H Club work. He attended the public schools at Quarryville where he was active in the Future Farmers of America.
