Last week, the committee gathered tobacco from some 20

farms around the county and graded the samples according to the newly-established U. S. Department of Agriculture standards for Pennsylvania seedleaf (Type 41) cigar filler tobacco.

Grading was done by H. C. Meyers, a retired tobacco farmer and former judge of local tobacco shows and the tobacco classes at the Pennsylvania Farm Show.

Samples packed and shipped to Rotterdam included hands of three wrapper grades, two gra-

des of untied pulloff, and two grades of farm filler. The committee also included a suggested per pound price for each grade - f o b New York, in 70 pound bales.

Robert Hess, Strasburg R1, president of the Lancaster County Farmers Association, said the program is an outgrowth of a discussion between local members and AFBF personnel in Washington, D C in December 1963.
