Keys To Keeping Quality In Milk

Refrigerate milk quickly after it's delivered or after you bring it from the store. Bright heat can affect milk flavor. In as little as 15 minutes exposure to sunlight can cause milk to lose vitamins.

Keep milk cold. After you take what you need from the container, return the unused milk promptly to the refrigerator. Cold preserves the fresh flavor and the milk keeps longer.

Keep milk covered at all times. Milk absorbs odors easily from other foods especially such foods as onions and fish.

Use oldest milk first. When you get a fresh supply put it to the back of the refrigerator, then use the oldest milk first.
