Zimmerman Has Top Herd In County DHIA

The herd of Paul B Zimmerman, Ephrata R1, had the highest butterfat average in the Red Rose Dairy Herd Improvement Association during December.

This herd of 26 registered Holsteins averaged 1815 pounds of milk and 75 pounds of butterfat with a 41 per cent test.

Second high herd was the 19 registered Holsteins owned by Bennie L Fisher, Ronks R1 with 71 pounds of butterfat in 1,935 pounds of milk with a 37 per cent test.

High individual cow completing her lactation during the month was "Dolores", a registered Holstein in the herd of C Robert Greider, Columbia R2. She had 19,236 pounds of milk with a 47 test and 896 pounds of butterfat in 305 days.

Second high cow, a registered Holstein owned by J Mowery Frey and son made 879 pounds of butterfat in 23,405 pounds of milk with a 38 per cent test.
