The 256 head of show hogs averaged 212 pounds and commanded an average price of \$16.67 a hundredweight including the champions. A year ago the sale averaged \$17.23.

The 24 showmen grossed \$9,054.48 on consignments weighing a total of 54,315 lbs. Auctioneer for the sale sponsored by the Lancaster Livestock Exchange, was Wilbur Hosler, former 4-H Club youth.
