\$6,000 Paid For Drought Aid

The Federal Crop Insurance Corp. paid out \$6,000 in drought

relief to Lancaster County farmers, a federal official said Tuesday. Ed Gamber, Pennsylvania's

agency director, said the payments were made to cover losses resulting from the prolonged summer drought last year.

In the five-county Central Pennsylvania area served by Gamber's agency, payments amounted to \$124,775

Payments in the counties were

Cumberland County \$39,681; Dauphin \$20,761; Lebanon \$43,776, York \$14,557, and Lancaster \$6,000.

Gamber said if all the insurable grain acreage in these five counties were covered by crop insurance, payments would have amounted to about \$16 million

Only 13,692 acres were insured last year, he said.
