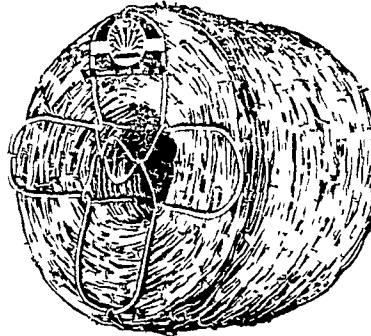

The 1963-crop filler and pull-off has also been sold, Hess said, with pool resale checks mailed to growers by May 10. The 1963-crop wrappers have not been resold as yet, he said.
