- 1½ cups cooked chopped spinach, drained (10 ounce package, frozen)
- 3 eggs, separated
- 1 cup shredded process American cheese

Cook noodles in boiling salted water, until tender, yet firm, 4 to 5 minutes. Drain. Meanwhile, melt butter or margarine in large saucepan. Blend in flour, salt, pepper and nutmeg. Add milk gradually, stirring constantly. Cook over moderate heat until smooth and thick, stirring constantly, about 3 minutes. Stir in spinach. Beat egg yolks slightly. Beat egg whites until stiff but not dry, peaks form. Gradually add about 1 cup sauce to egg yolks, stirring constantly. Return egg yolk mixture to remaining sauce, mixing well. Cook over moderate heat about 1 minute, stirring constantly. Gently stir

noodles into sauce. Fold beaten egg whites into noodle mixture. Turn into lightly greased 9 inch square pan. Sprinkle cheese evenly over noodle mixture. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) 45 to 50 minutes or until silver knife inserted halfway between center and edge comes out clean. Cut into squares to serve.

Grain Storage Same As 1963

HARRISBURG—Total stocks of all stored grain in the Keystone State on April 1, both on-farm and off-farm totaled 419 million bushels, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service. This was the same amount as on hand April, 1963, but 40 per cent below the January 1, 1964 total.

Corn held in all storage positions in Pennsylvania totaled 224 million bushels on April 1 for the smallest stocks since 1948. On-farm holdings of 198 bushels were down 10 per cent from a year earlier and the lowest since 1958.

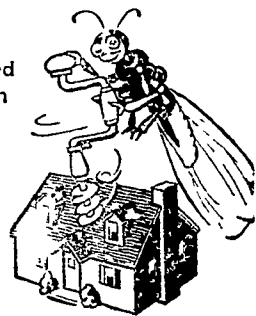
