Calf and lamb liver are particularly mild in flavor but more pork and beef liver is available. Because calves liver is mild and rather limited in supply it commands a higher price than other kinds of liver.

Pork and beef liver are equally satisfactory for most dishes. Calves liver cooks quickly because it is tender but all liver needs slow cooking at a low temperature

Try cooking liver by methods other than frying. Baking, cooking in a casserole, braising and stewing are other good ways to cook it. You can broil liver, too, but you will want to marinate all but calves liver before you cook it.

Topdress nitrogen on wheat grains will do the most if put on immediately

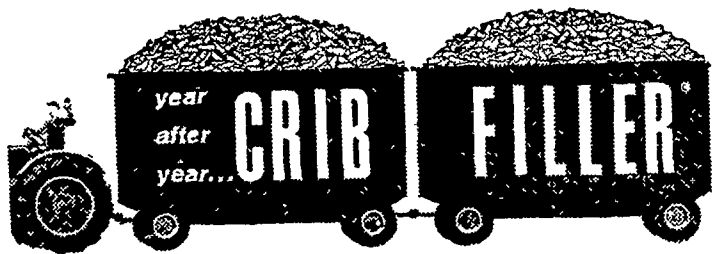
