Higher temperature and humidity under the plastic probably accounts for much of the difference, Engle believes Temperatures during the daylight hours have averaged seven to ten degrees higher under plastic than glass, and the temperatures reached desirable ranges much earlier in the day

Humidity under the plastic ranges much higher than under glass Watering does not need
