133 Classes In Horse Show

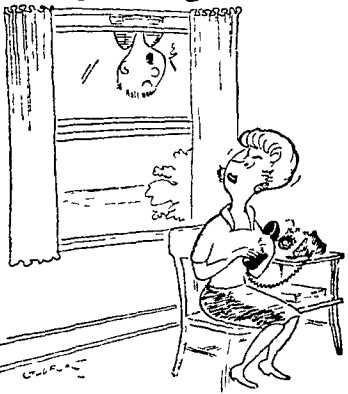
The Lancaster Horse Show and County Fair, co-sponsored for the third year by the Lancaster Riding and Tennis Club and the St Joseph Hospital Auxiliary, will be held this weekend, June 5, 6 and 7. Top show horses will compete for honors at the Lancaster Riding and Tennis Club grounds, Lincoln Highway West.

With one hundred and thirty-three classes listed, the show promises to be larger than ever. The addition of a new ring at the Club will enable events to be held continuously, eliminating many of the delays between events.

The opening session will be at 9 a.m. on June 5 with sessions scheduled morning, afternoon and evening through June 7. A ladies' and men's western pleasure division is listed for Sunday morning. This competition will be for the one hundred dollar Western Pleasure Championship Stake.

An exhibition of Firejumping will be a special feature on Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights. Billy Marshall, from Annville, Pa., will take his horse, Anthracite, over five flaming hurdles in the dark, first with bridle and saddle, again with only a bridle, and then with only a neck rein.
