No Salmonella Society of Farm Women In Clean Eggs

Clean, unbroken, shell eggs have never been recognized as the guilty party in an outbreak of salmonellosis, according to Dr. Eldon E. Rice, Scientific Consultant to the Poultry and Egg National Board.

He cited surveillance studies, such as those being carried out at the Communicable Disease Center of the U. S. Public Health Service in Atlanta, Georgia. The team of scientists working there has found that sound, clean eggs are not presently involved in salmonellosis, a disease caused by foodborne bacteria.

Drug manufacturers are required to report promptly to the Food and Drug Administration any information they get regarding adverse effects from new drugs and antibiotics on the market.
