Beef Prices at Record Lows

Beef supplies are expected to be about 6 per cent larger during the second quarter of this year than last. Prices are now near the lowest levels of seven years. The supply-price situation for beef will be the same in June as it was in May. However, the record slaughter rates of the past two weeks may indicate that the crest of the cattle wave has passed. Many beef retailers are thrifty buys but special emphasis is being placed on economy steaks this week such as chuck and round.

Grilling Less Tender Steaks

Many retailers are merchandising steaks of all kinds because of the popularity of outdoor eating. Less tender steaks may be grilled if they are of U. S. Choice grade or comparable quality. The best of the less tender steaks would be the arm chuck or the top muscle of the round, sold as top round. It still may be best to first tenderize these steaks before grilling either by mechanical means or with a commercial enzyme preparation.

Fruit Values Limited

There's no great news in the strawberry market yet. Hot, dry weather has effected the quality of berries from nearby states. The first Pennsylvania berries should begin to appear this week and peak during the third week of June in many areas of the State.

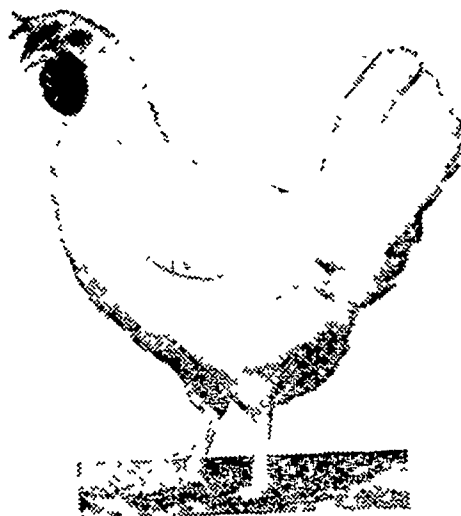

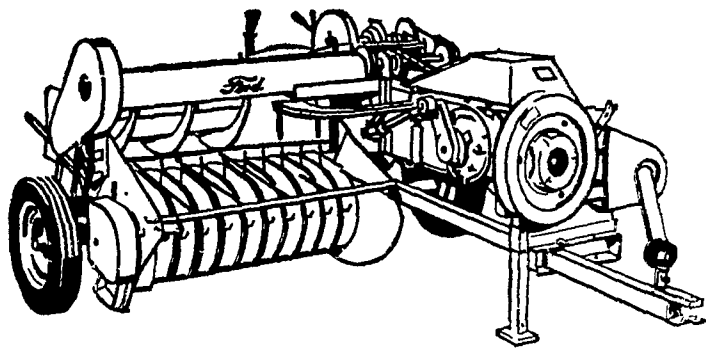
