Fresh Holstein cows brought \$250-350; Guerneys \$150-250, and other breeds \$150-225. Stock bulls were \$140-185, and stock heifers made \$65-170.

At the June 1 horse sale the 279 head of horses and ponies brought steady prices. Riding horses were \$125-400, driving horses \$125-225, the killer horses 7 to 7½ cents a pound. Pony mares were \$40-110 and geldings \$40-125.

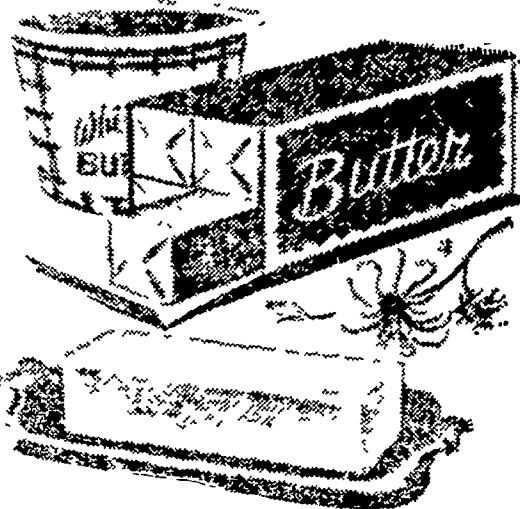
Market hogs were 25 higher as 402 head sold at the June 1 auction. Retail hogs to local butchers brought 18-19, while grades 1 to 3 went to the packers at 17.25 to 18. Heavyweight hogs brought 16-17.

The 35 shoats sold for \$7.50 to \$11 per head.

The 90 calves at the June 1 sale were steady to 1.00 higher. Choice vealers were 31-34, good and low choice 28-31, standard 25-28, and cull and common 20-24.

A total of 25 lambs weighing 70-90 pounds brought 24-25.

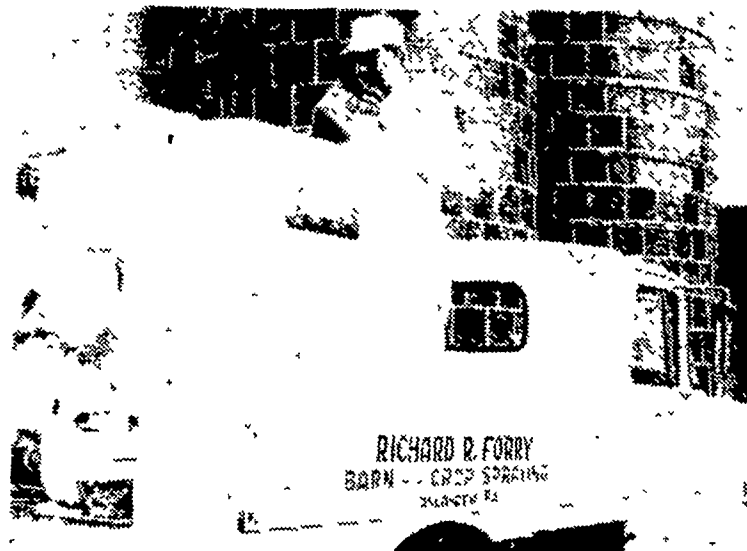
