MINTED ORANGE-CHEESE SALAD

- 1 pint cottage cheese
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh mint leaves
- 3 oranges, peeled, sliced into cartwheels

Salad greens

Combine cottage cheese and chopped mint on individual salad plates, arrange orange slices on salad greens. Top with minted cottage cheese.

When using either type of interfacing fabric, use the original pattern for cutting the pieces. Choose a fabric for the interfacing that is the same or lighter in weight than the fabric in the garment. Also select an interfacing fabric that takes the same care as the garment fabric.

Ripe Olives

Ripe olives come pitted and unpitted and in at least nine different sizes. A picture of the size and the approximate number of ripe olives in the can are on the label as a guide to buying what you need

Don't Cut Tulip Leaves

It doesn't always pay to be neat, especially if you're raising spring-flowering bulbs. Af-

ter the tulips, daffodils, and hyacinths have bloomed, don't cut the leaves back. After the foliage has turned yellow, you can cut it back. As long as the leaves are green, they're building next year's bulbs.

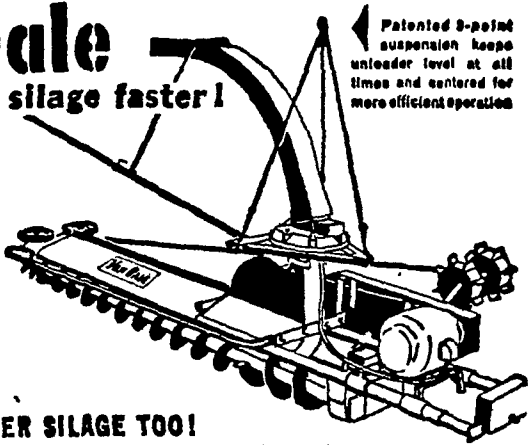

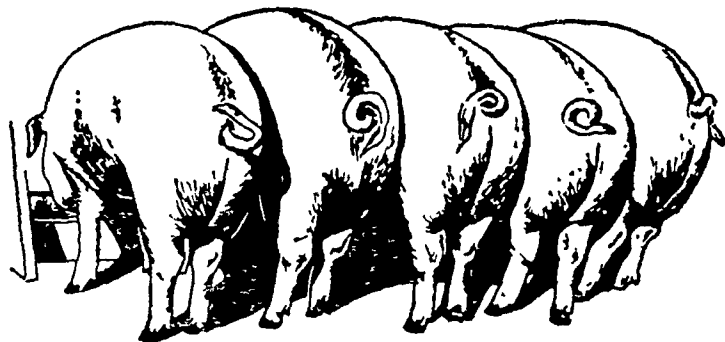
